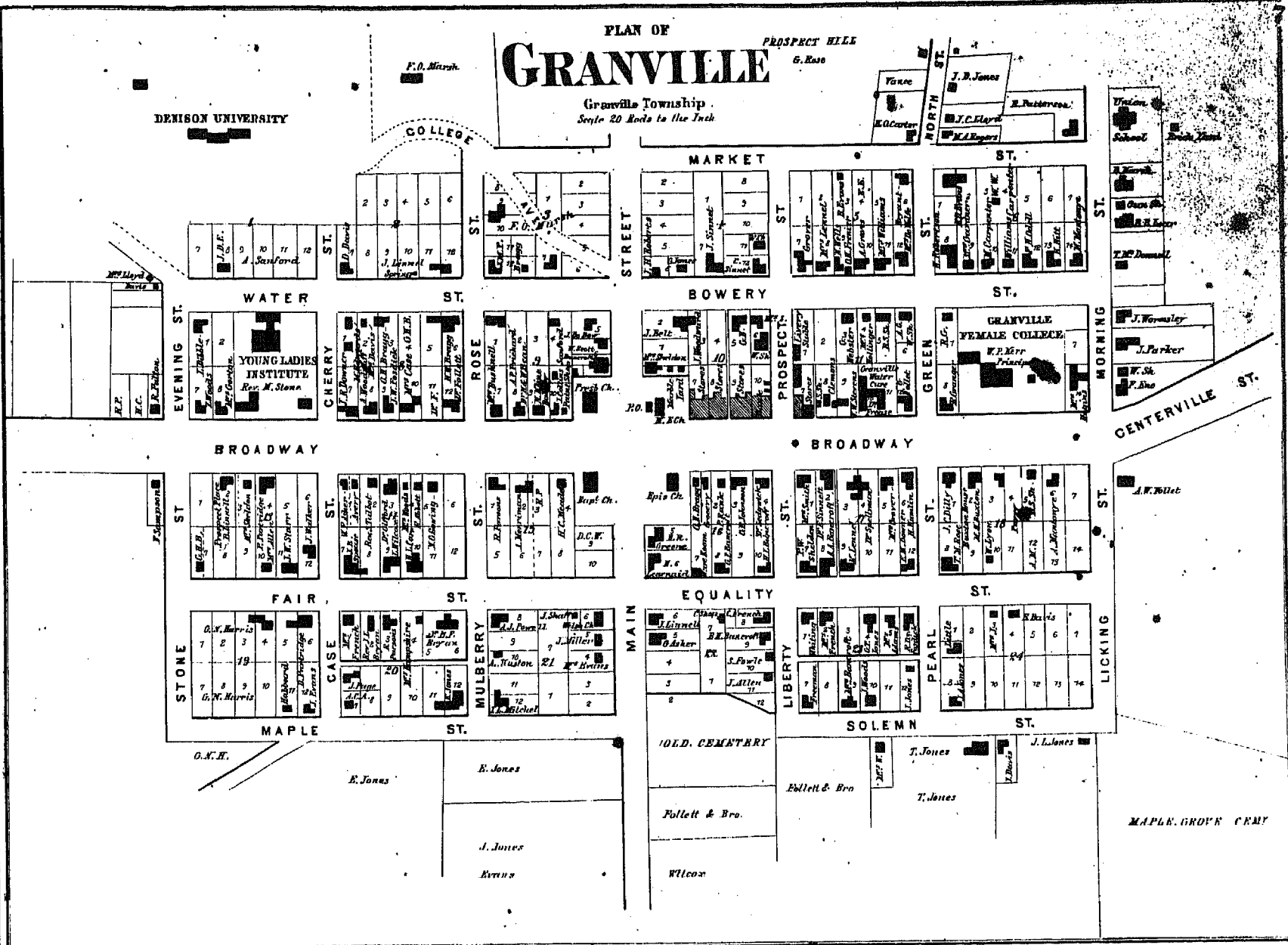

### PLAN OF MAPLE GROVE CEMETERY Granville TP



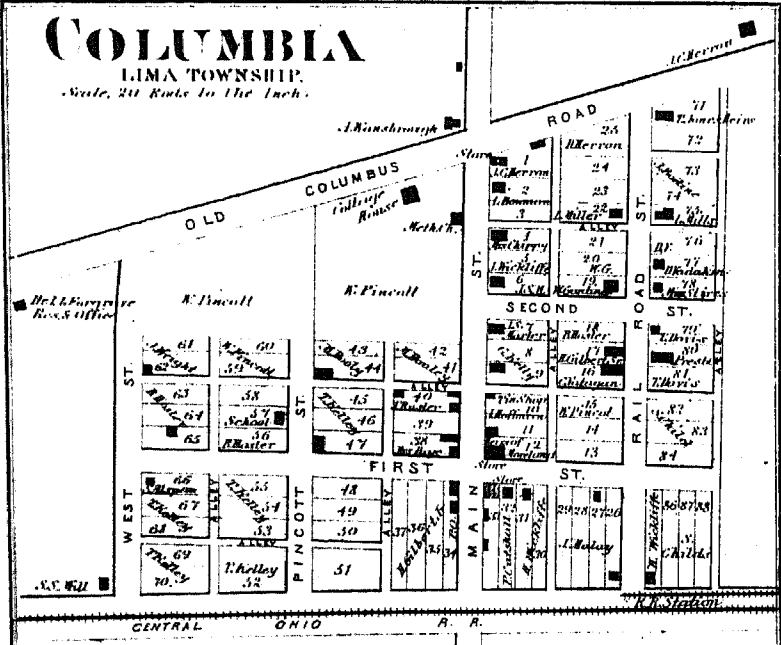

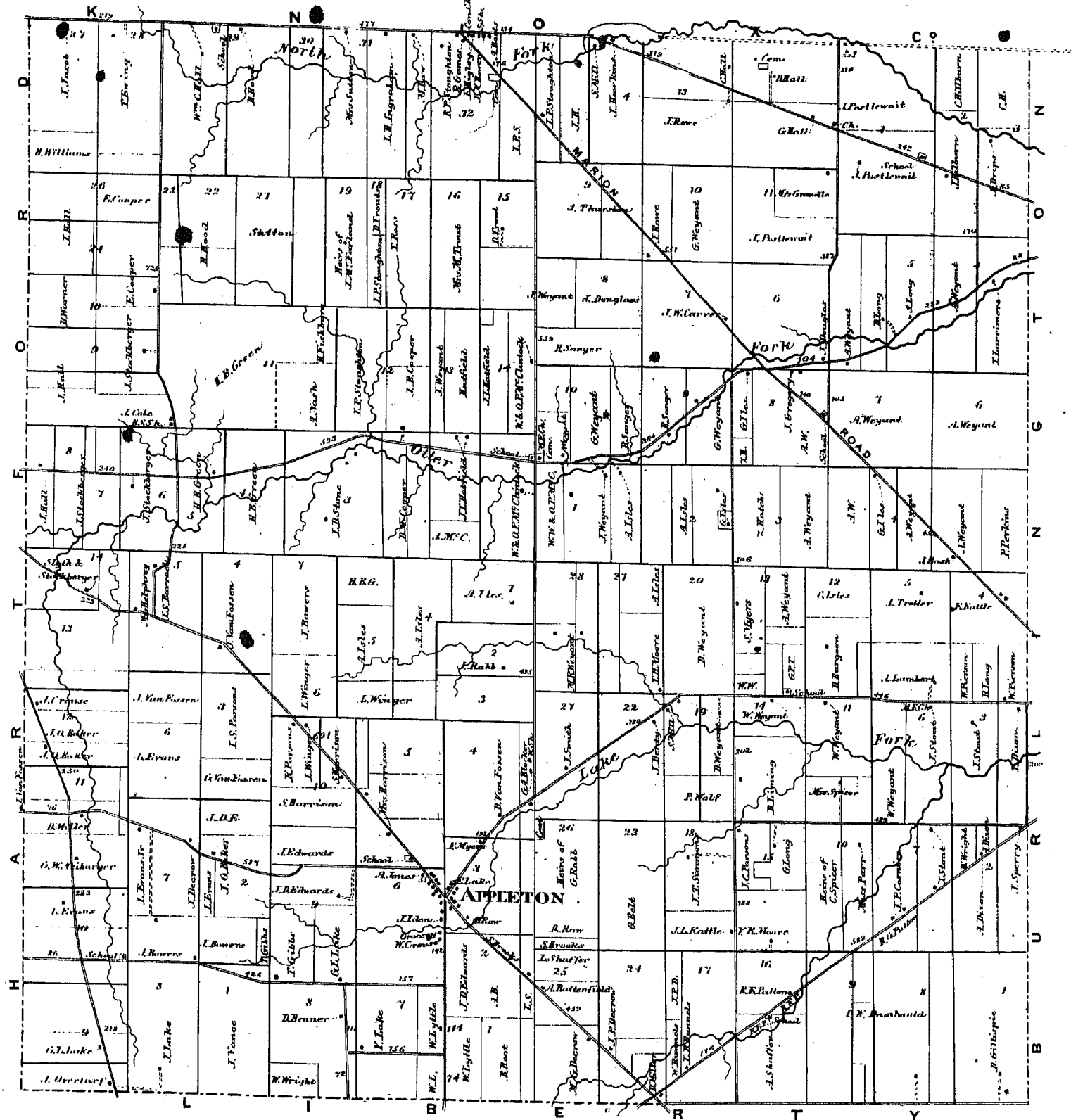




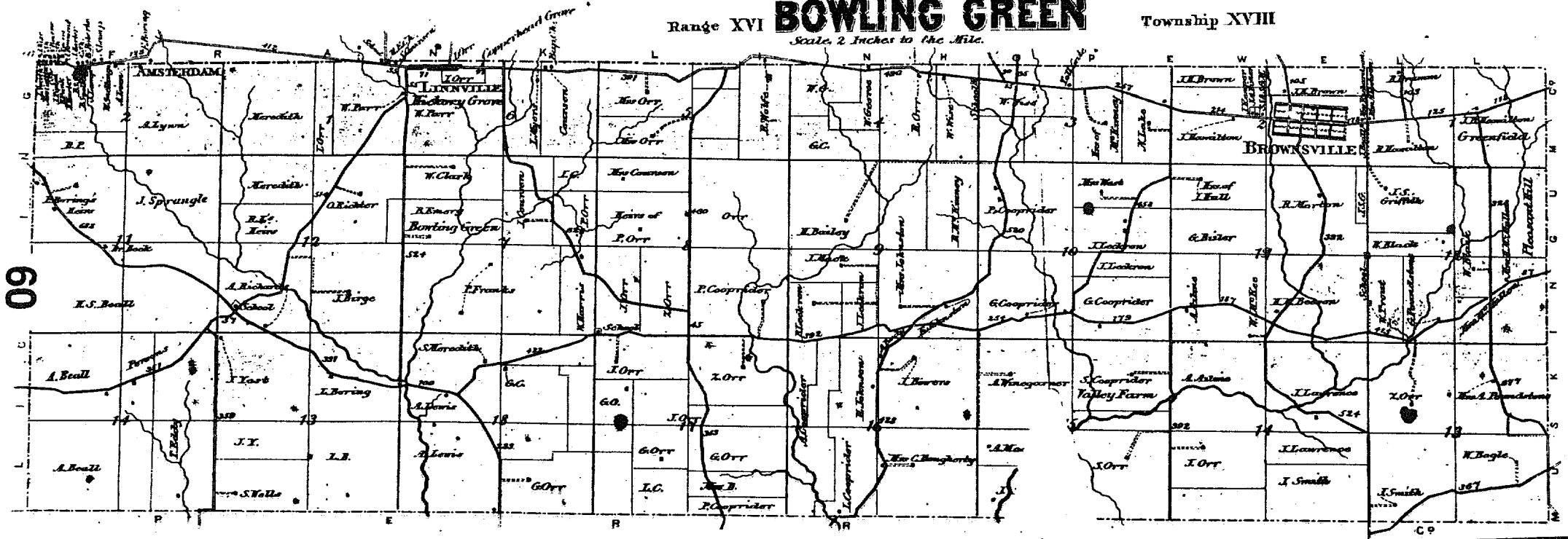


PLAN OF RANGE XIV BENNINGTON TOWNSHIP IV

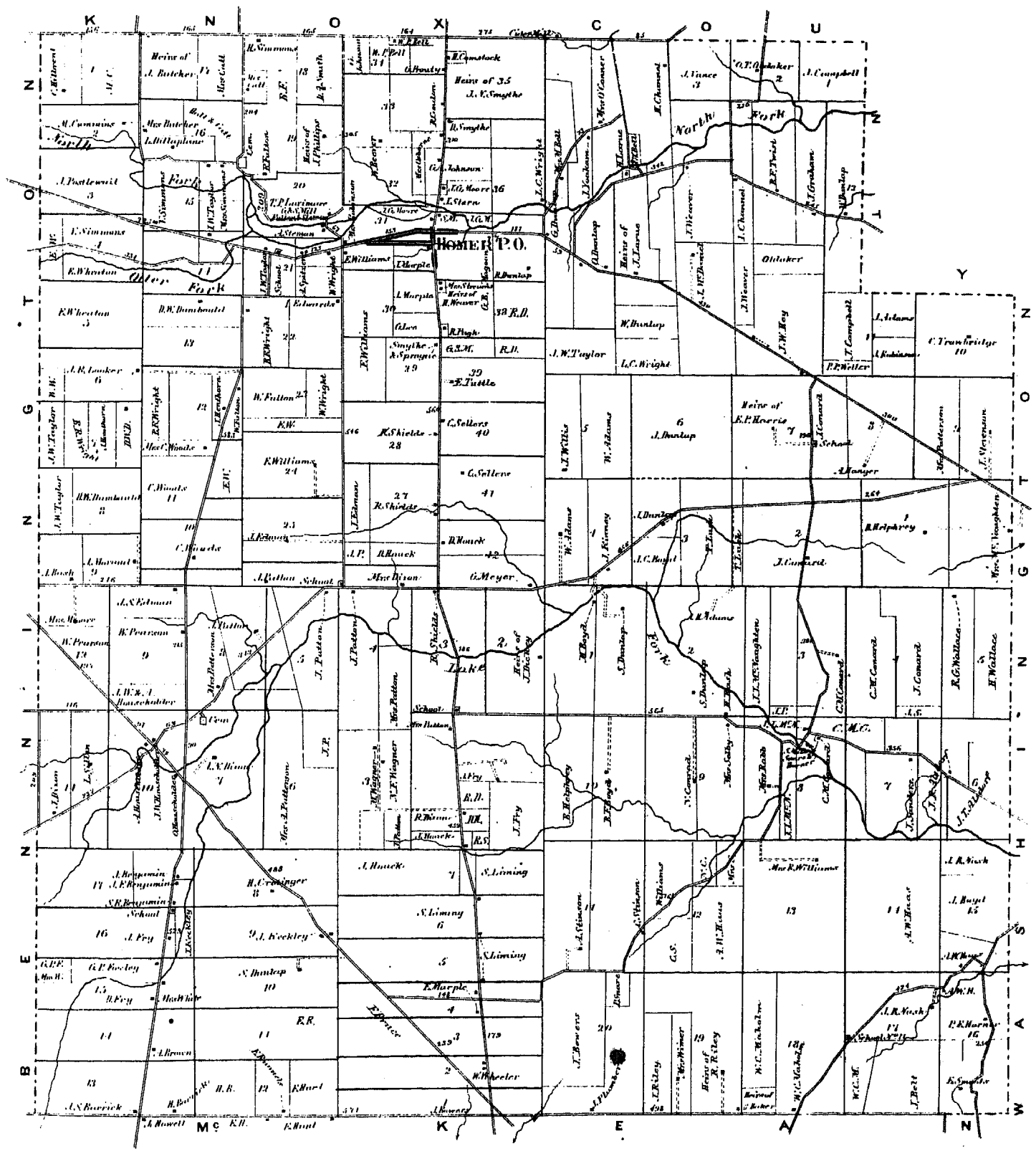

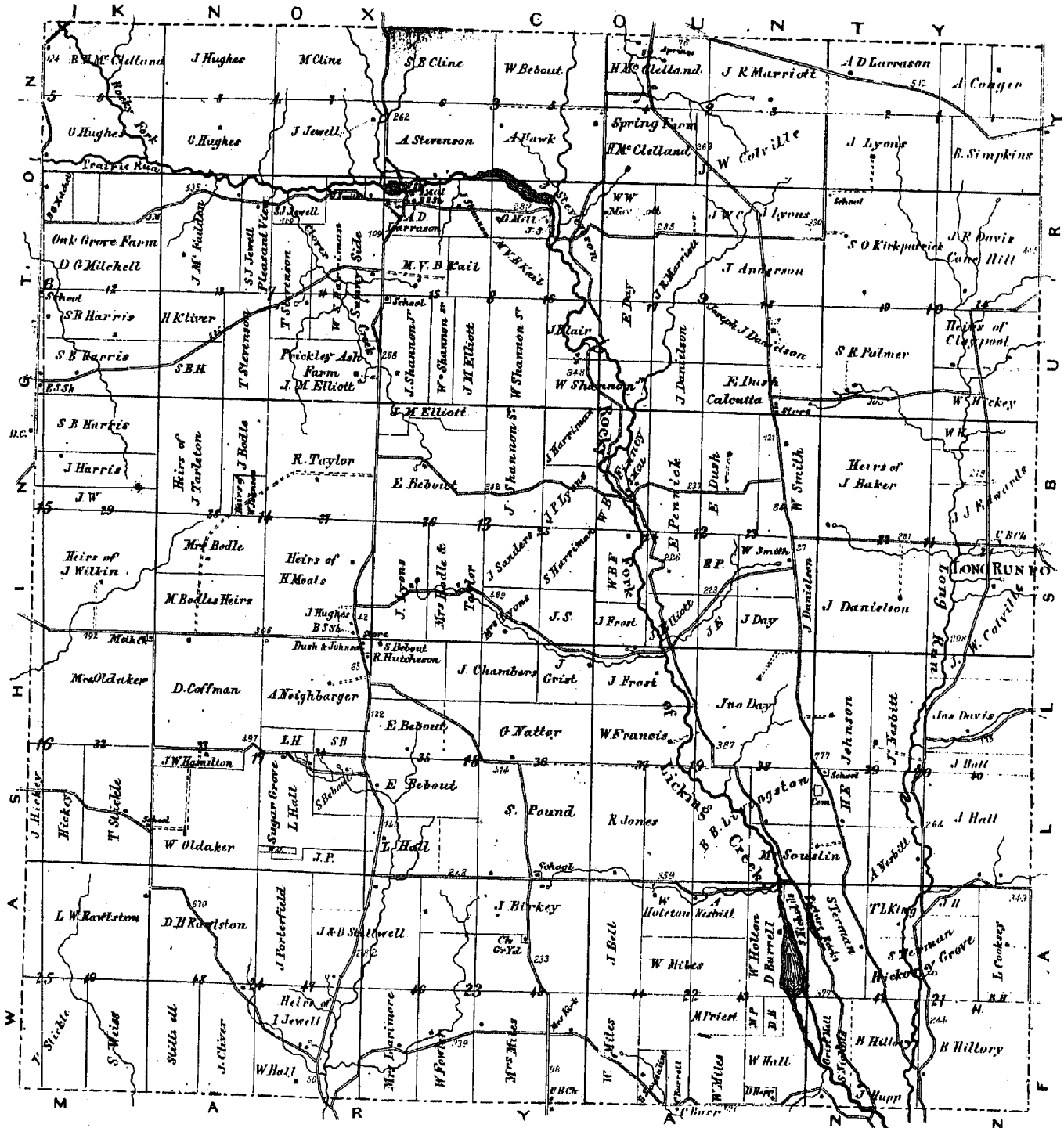
PLAN OF

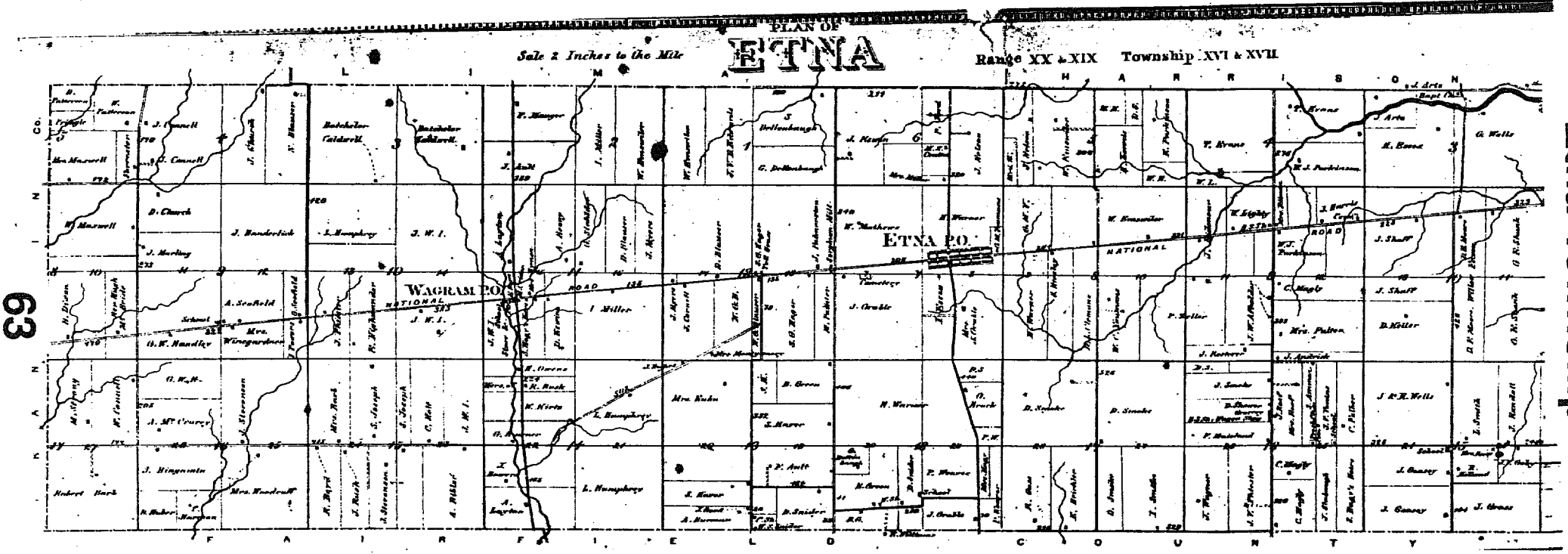
PLAN OF

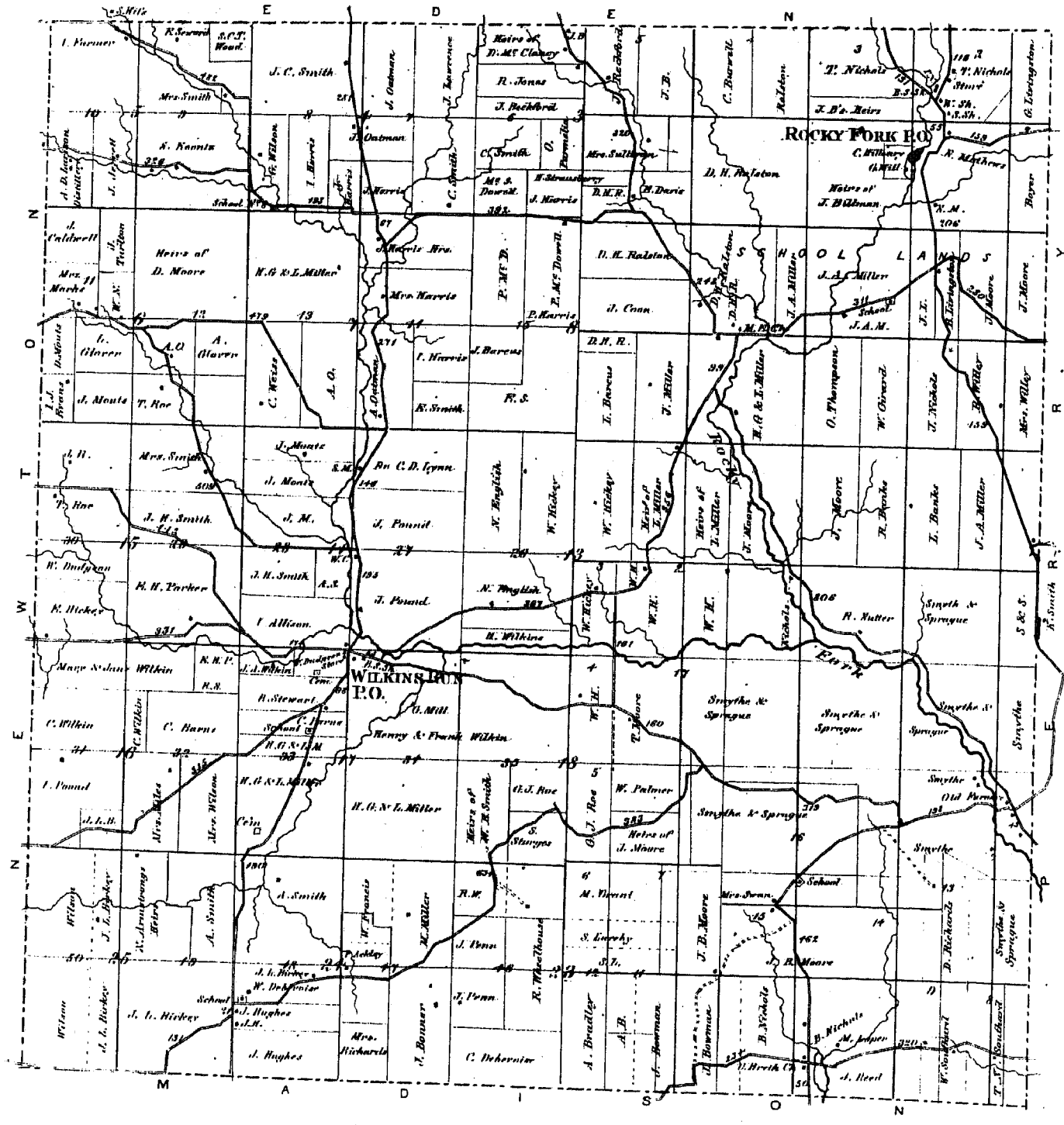


PLAN OF

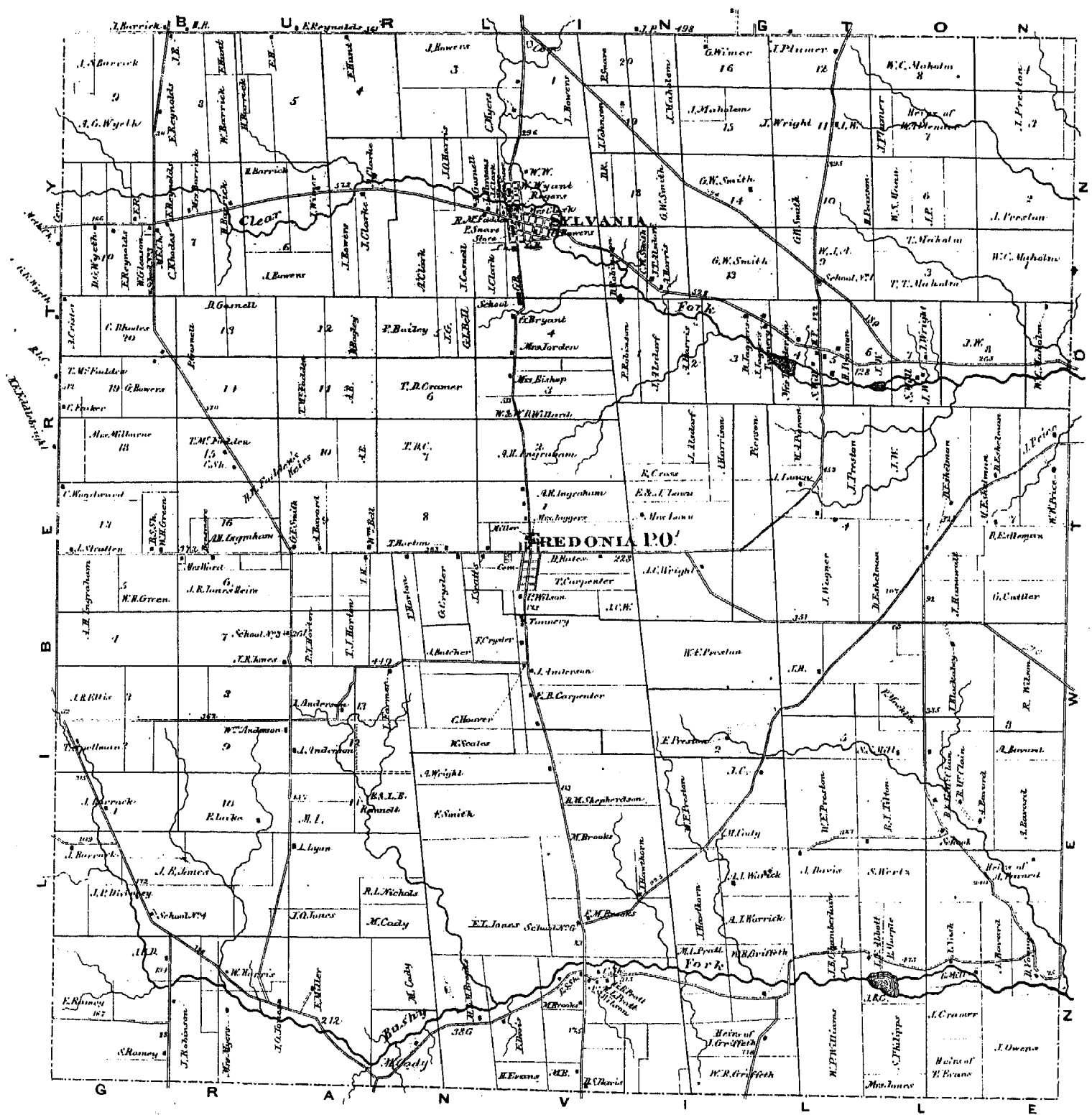

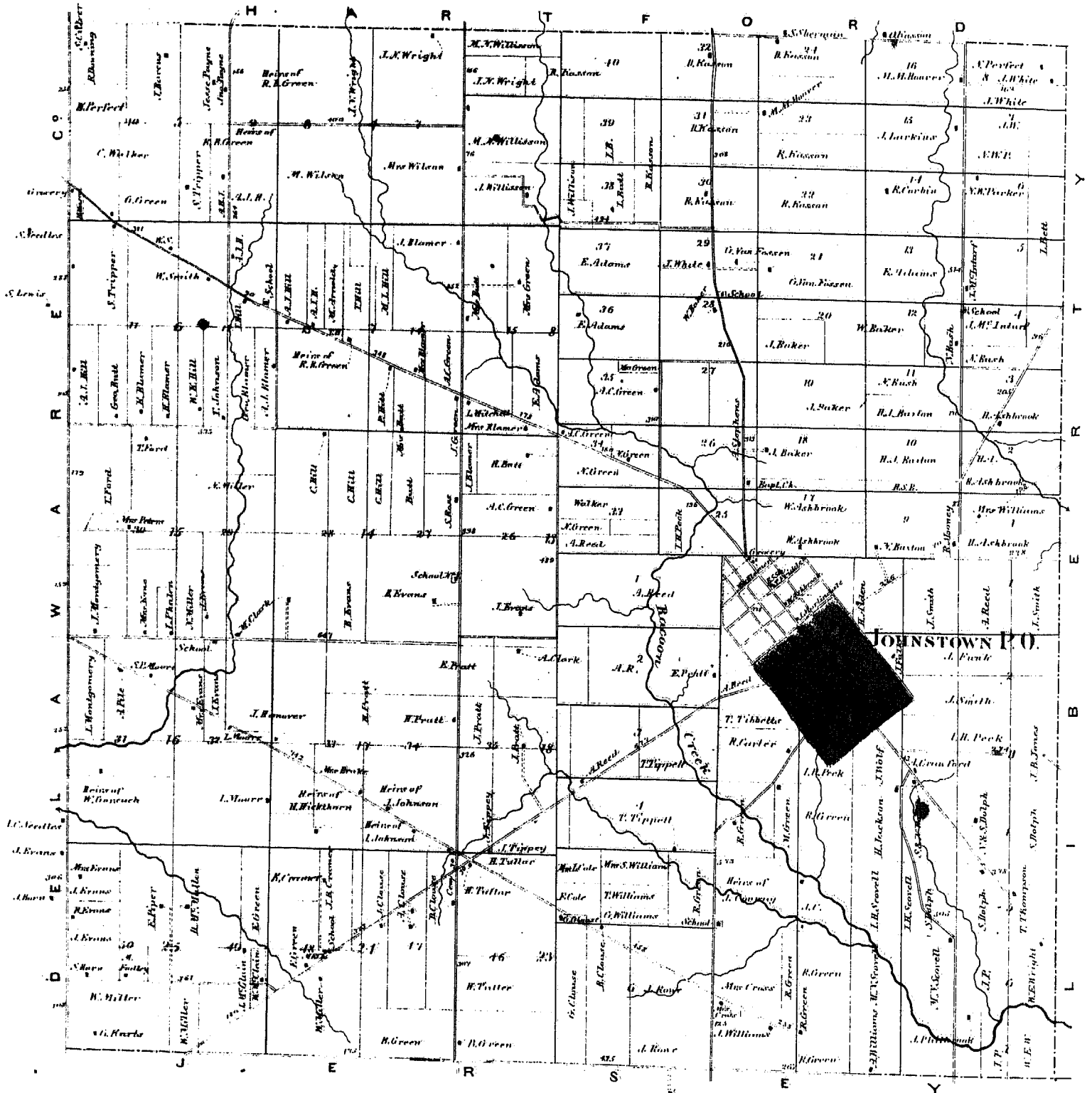

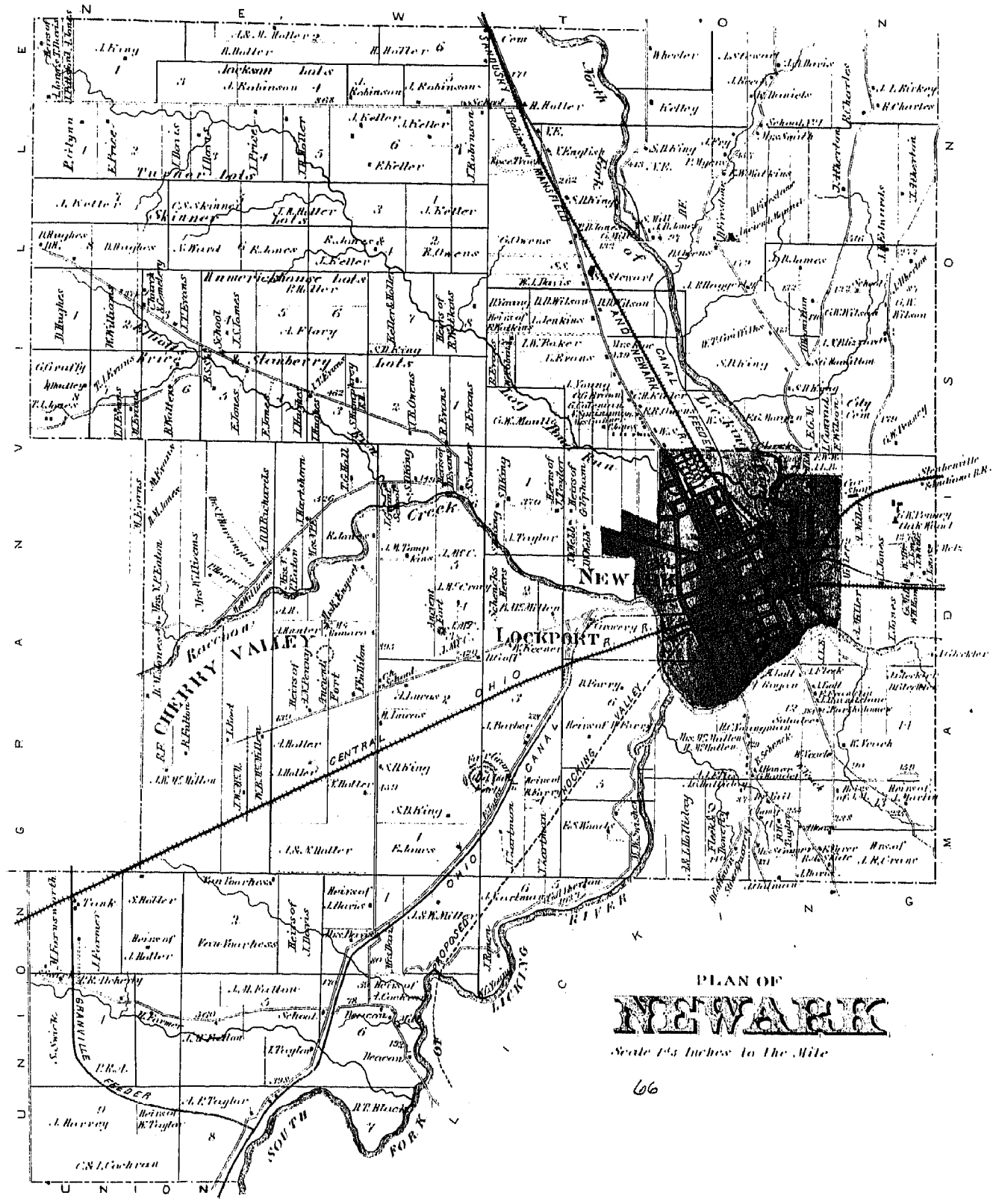


RANGE XIII **McKEAN** TOWNSHIP III

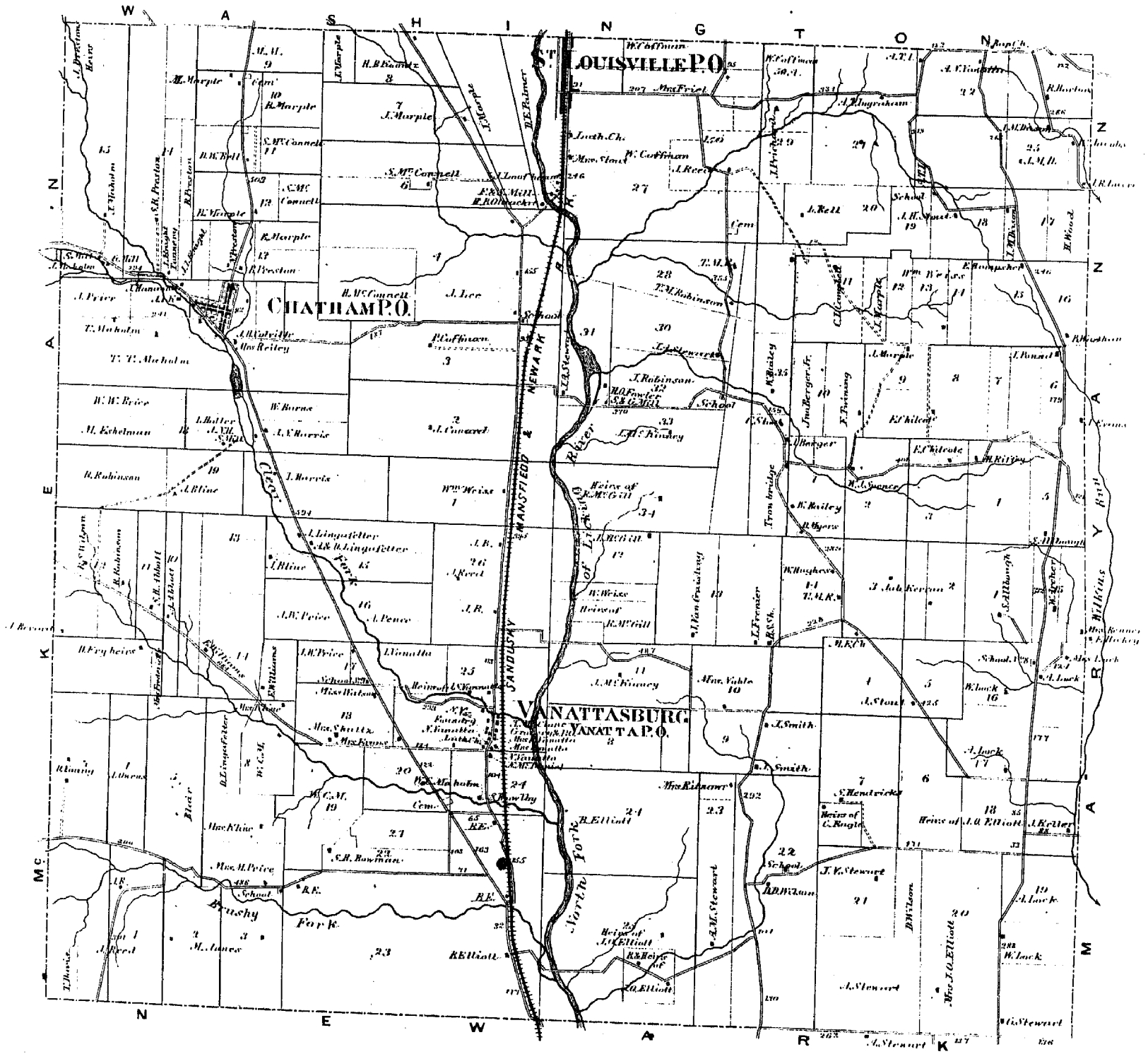

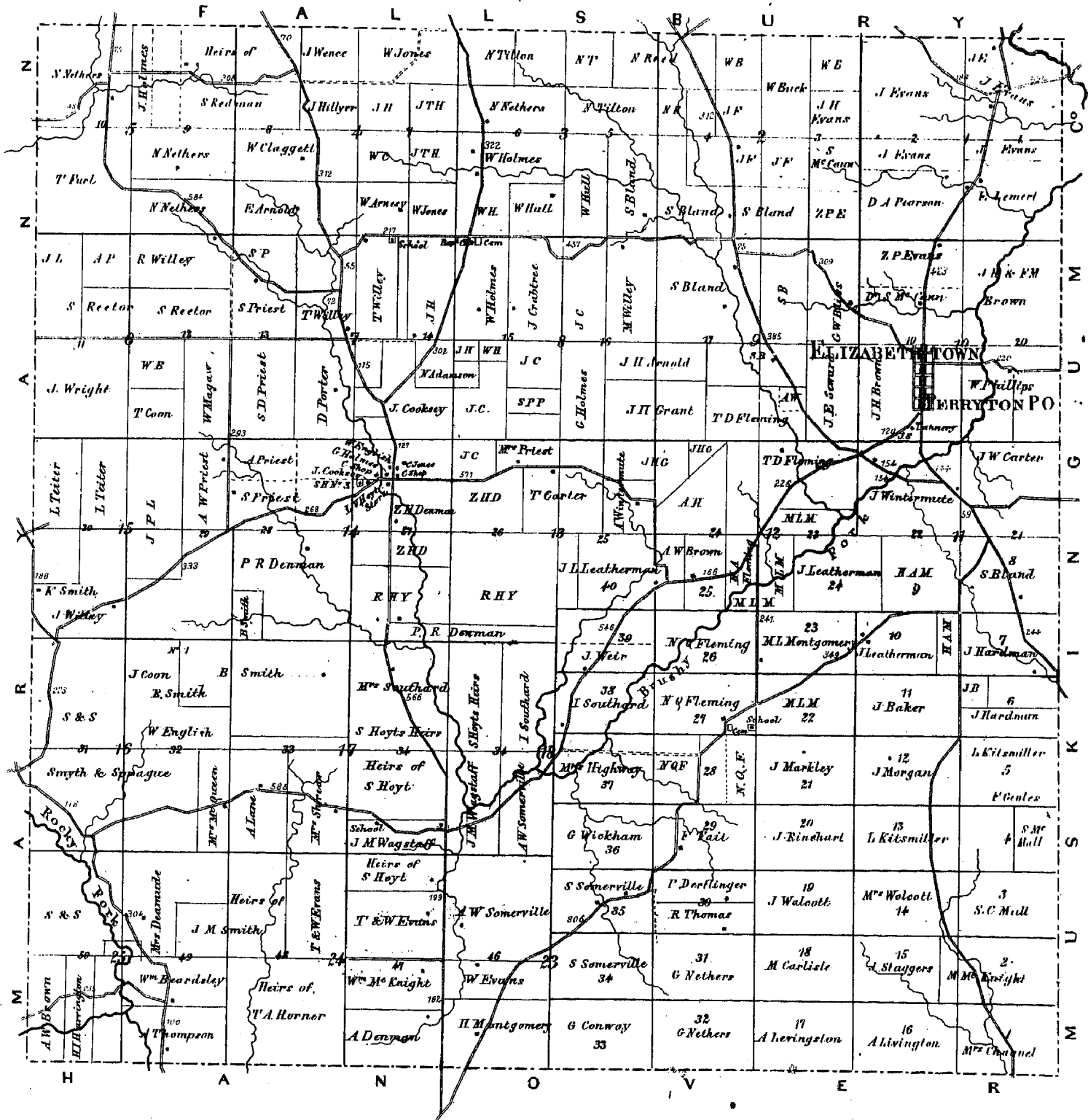




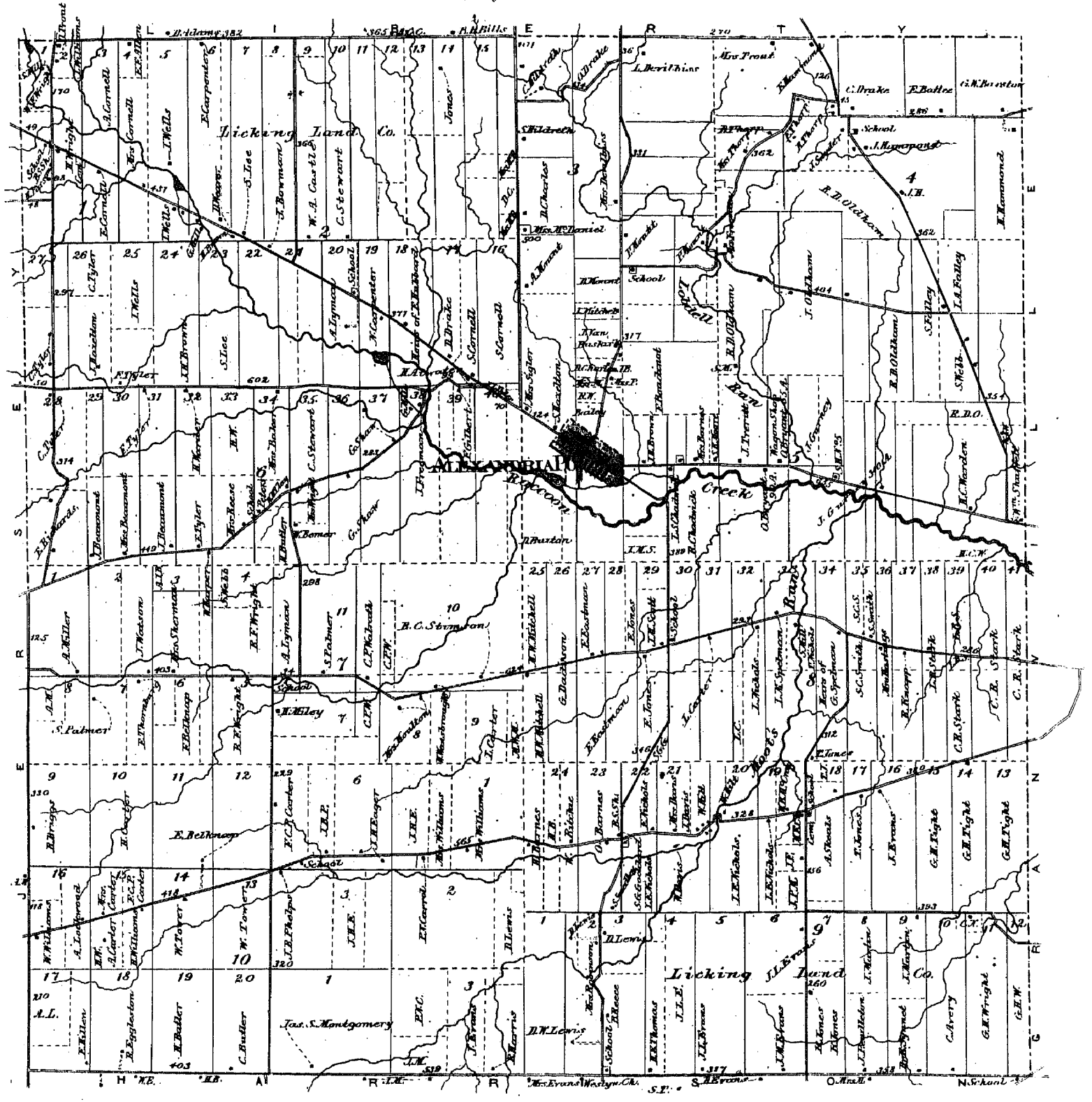
PLAN OF
