most early Prob. County waterpowered mills were combinations of grist and saw mills. Grist mills required the most power and so there were many establishments in later years where sawing lumber was the sole operation. There also were several side lines of business in connection with those earliest grist mills, whisky was in great demand and settlers raised the kind of corn that would produce the most whisky. Settlers and Indians would barter furs and skins for whisky so the miller established a tan yard to convert the skins into leather. He also ran a distillery to convert some of his grist into that commodity. To use up distillery still, a by-product, he had a hog lot where he fattened hogs on the still.

GASPER

A slaughter house converted the hogs into lard and pork and a packing house prepared those items and marketed them.

Small water-powered local grist mills were put out of business by the advent of roller mills. Flour from roller mills was superior to flour from buhrs and small mill owners were unable to stand the high cost of installing roller mills.

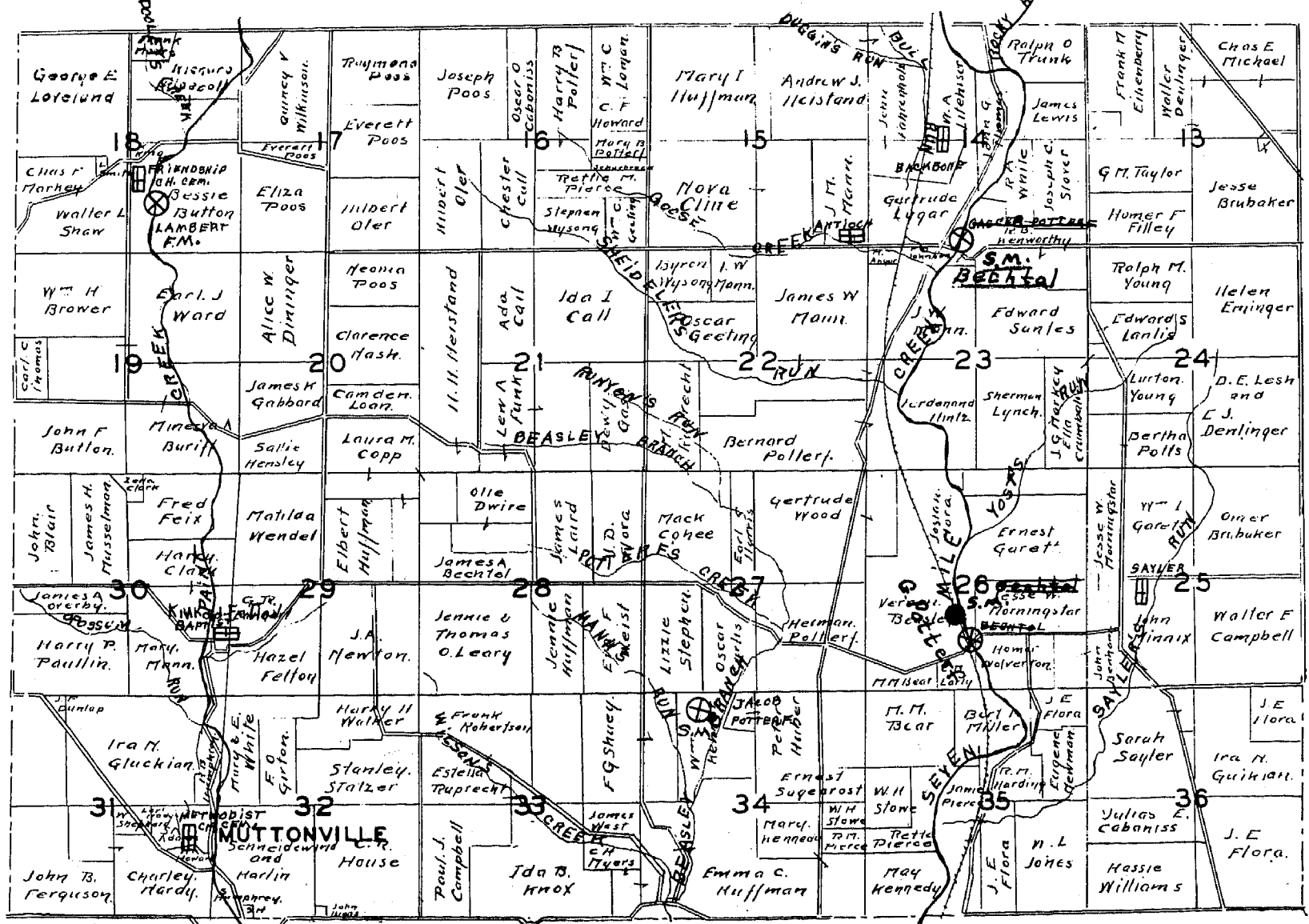
